## **Transcript – Pulling it All Together**

We have spent time looking at three different documents that will help us transition to the Revised TEKS (2012). Take a moment to reflect on how these three documents are related.

Now that you've had a moment to reflect on the Venn diagram and how these three documents are related, consider the following:

- The Revised Mathematics TEKS (2012) is at the heart of each document.
- The Focal Points and Side-by-Side documents provide the complete student expectations, including the personal financial literacy standards from the Revised Mathematics TEKS (2012).
- The Side-by-Side document is the only one that has both the current and the revised TEKS in the document.
- The Vertical Look has summaries of the vertical development of ideas that are connected to the end grade-level key concepts and procedures.
- The Side-by-Side and Vertical Look documents are organized by strands (current versus Revised Mathematics TEKS).
- The Focal Points bundle the student expectations to form connections between student expectations.
