

TUITION

- Tuition is waived for PSJA dual enrollment students.
- Dual enrollment students may receive a bill to pay tuition. If so, notify your college ECHS Coordinator/Liaison to assist in verifying that the ECHS student is coded as a dual enrollment student.
- Request college professors to teach dual enrollment courses on campus. Professors will have to be paid for every section taught (Dual Enrollment Course Agreements).
- If a student has to be registered for a course after the census date, a \$150 fee will be charged to the ECHS.

TRANSPORTATION

- Budget needs to include transportation costs for the students taking courses at the college campus.
- Transportation to and from the college campus is needed during the regular school year and in the summer.
- Lunch is purposefully scheduled for the students before they leave and when they arrive from college campus.



TEACHERS

- Selection of highly qualified staff—teachers with a Masters Degree to teach dual enrollment courses on campus
- Teachers use data-driven instruction, aligned standards and scope and sequence instruction, high-quality curricular materials, share responsibility and accountability for student learning, common instruction framework



TRAINING

- Collaborative training between higher education partner and early college high school on college and high school policies for all dual enrollment staff.
- ECHS staff is trained to become college advisors.
- ECHS staff is trained on side-by-side high school/associate degree plans.




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TEXTBOOKS
