- · 6) School Design





PAC – Early College HS Projected Participants 2014-2019





The ECHS Blueprint establishes 3 phases for an ECHS program at an institution:

- · 1) Initiating
- · 2) Implementing
- · 3) Exemplar

Focus on collaborative effort to move into *Exemplar* Phase by developing 12 month, 2 year and 5 year goals.

Develop a long-term strategic plan for *intelligent risk* decision-making and continuous *process improvement* related to ECHS.
