SB#1: Demonstrate and Practice—Context Clues

The U.S. government announced plans last week that would allow female military members to work closer to the front lines of <u>combat zones</u>, or dangerous areas where armed forces may be fighting. Women currently make up 14.5 percent of all active-duty members of the U.S. military. But until now, women have been officially <u>barred</u> from serving in any role near military units assigned to combat. Changing military policies can take years. Female forces have been seen in the military since the Revolutionary War, but women were not allowed to <u>enlist</u> and be officially registered until World War I.
