The City of Lights

Paris, the “City of Lights,” has much to offer its residents and visitors.

Paris is one of the most visited cities in Europe. It is also one of the most populated. Located in the north of France, Paris offers tourists many different activities.

The Louvre and other museums

Many people come to Paris to visit museums. The Louvre is one of the world’s most famous. Visitors can see famous artworks such as the *Mona Lisa* and the *Venus de Milo*. Museums with the art of Rodin and Picasso can also be found. The Museum of Modern Art is another popular tourist attraction.

Historical sites and monuments

Paris has many historical sites and landmarks. One of the most popular is the Eiffel Tower, which was built for the Paris Exposition of 1889. Another important landmark is the *Arc de Triomphe* (“Triumphal Arch”). This structure is a tall arch built to honor soldiers who died during the French Revolutionary War and the Napoleonic Wars.
