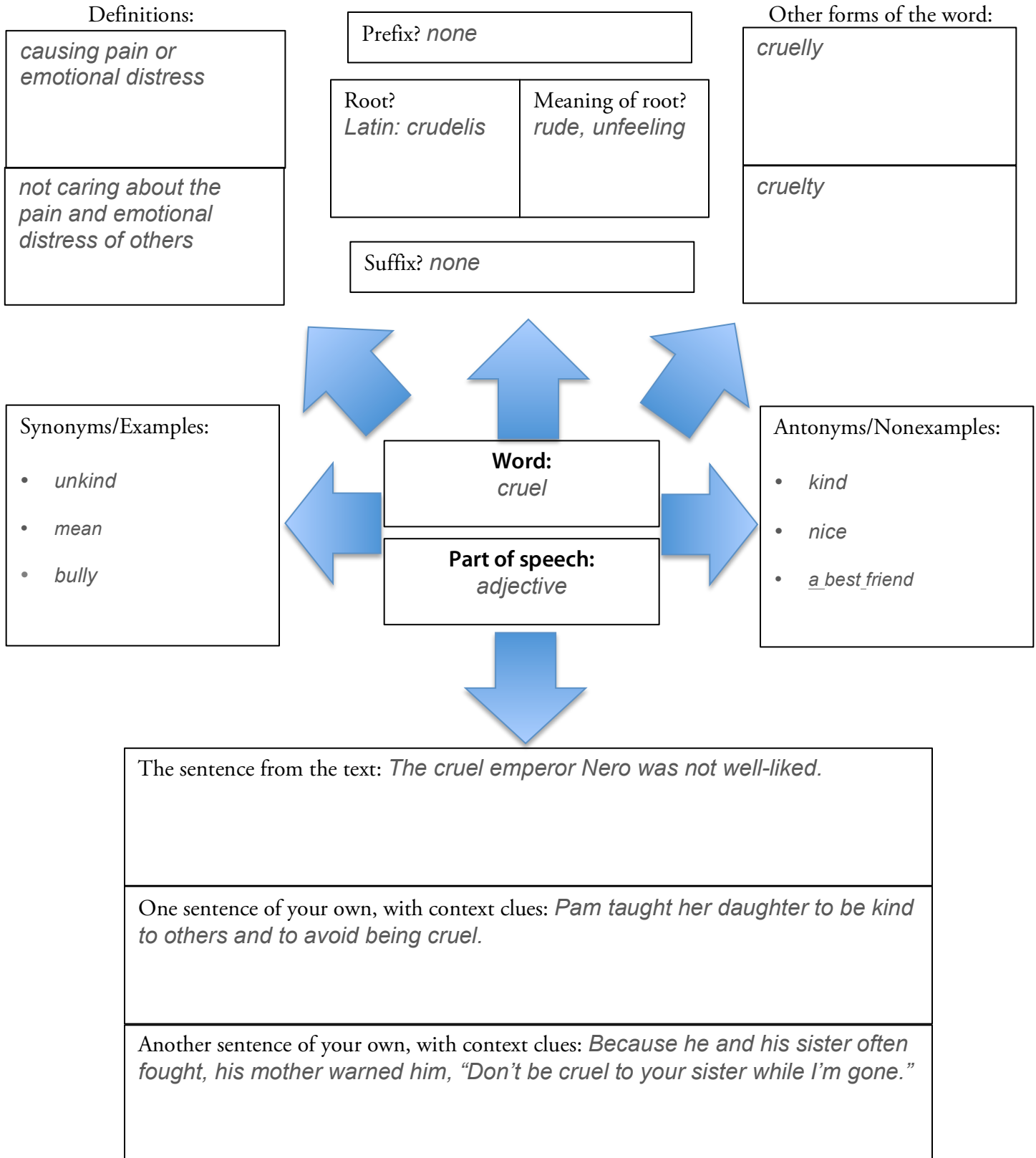

TM#2: Practice—Passage

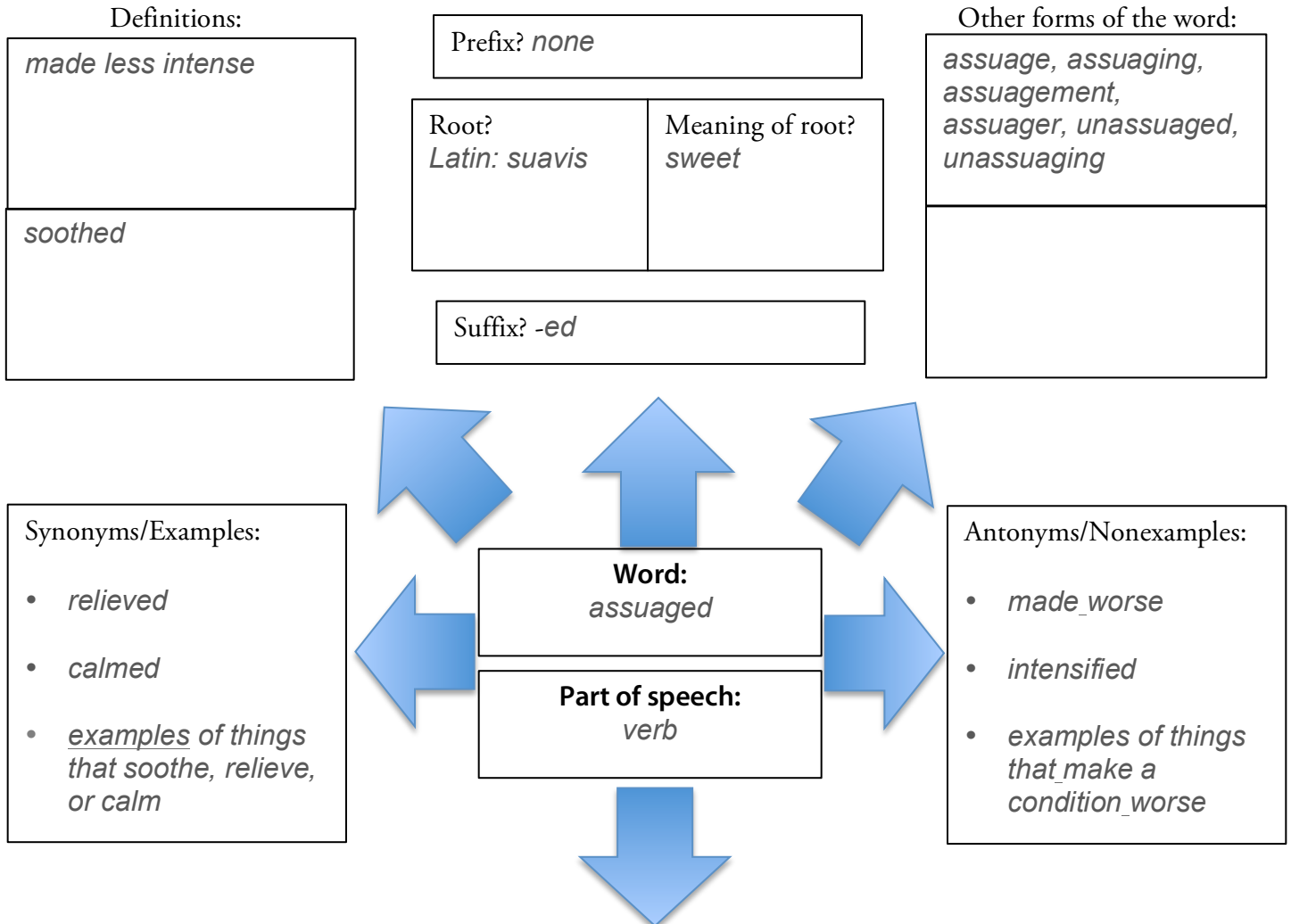

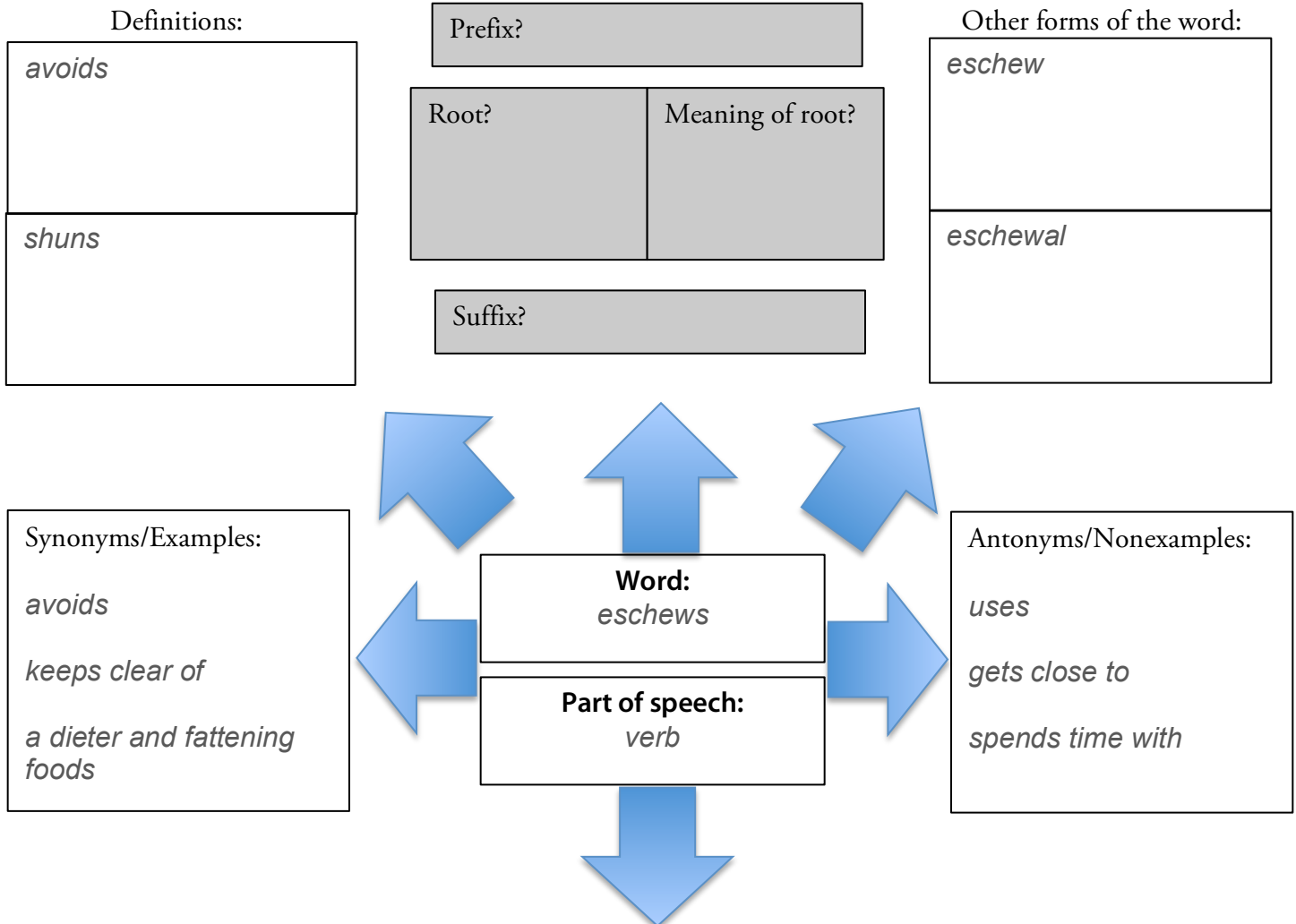
